The Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change has received financing from the World Bank for the cost of the Energy Efficiency in Public Buildings Project (EEPBP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

General Directorate of Construction Affairs (GDCA) of MoEUCC will serve as the main implementing agency for the Project. The overall objective of EEPBP is to reduce energy use in central government buildings and develop a transition plan to develop and scale-up suitable sustainable financing and institutional mechanisms to support a national program. The implementation period for the project is 5 years.

The consulting service (“the Services”) includes the hiring of a full-time **Mechanical Engineer** (EEPB/WB/MoEU/PIU-IND-ME-03) to support the GDCA’s Project Implementation Unit. The General Directorate of Construction Affairs now invites eligible individual consultants (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraphs 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” (July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018) (“Procurement Regulations”) setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest (<http://pubdocs.worldbank.org/en/178331533065871195/Procurement-Regulations.pdf>).

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the Approved Selection Methods for Individual Consultants set out in the Procurement Regulations. The contract will be signed between the General Directorate of Construction Affairs of MoEUCC and the consultant.
